Paris – Normandy – Loire Valley
June 22^d – July 1st



DAY 1 – Wednesday, June 21st Welcome to Paris

- **4:53pm** Welcome at Gare du Nord and transfer to your hotel.

DAY 2 – Thursday, June 22nd Paris Sightseeing

- Morning at leisure.
- **2 pm** Afternoon tour in Montmartre, and visit of the Sacré Coeur Basilica. You will then head to le Marais, another historical area of the city that was the heart of Parisian life until the 17th century. Le Marais is now on its way to be the trendiest place of the capital, and is home to a lot of independent boutiques and concept stores, art galleries, and chocolate and pastry shops.
- Night at Relais Christine.

DAY 3 – Friday, June 23rd Fontainebleau

- **9:00 am** Pick-up at your hotel and transfer to Fontainebleau (1,5-hour drive).
- **10:30 pm** Private guided visit of Fontainebleau estate.
- **1 pm** Lunch in a lovely typical Parisian bistrot.
This afternoon, enjoy the town of Fontainebleau or the nearby village of Barbizon before your transfer back to your hotel (1,5-hour drive). Amongst the prettiest villages in France, Barbizon is mainly famous for the pre-impressionist painters who lived and worked there from 1850 onwards, such as Corot, Millet, Monet, Renoir, or Sisley.
- **7:30 pm** Dinner at Thoumieux or Lipp.
- Night at Hotel Relais Christine.



DAY 4 – Saturday, June 24th Paris museums

- **9:30 am** Meet your guide at your hotel. Transfer to Orsay museum by private car or taxi.
- **10 am** Private guided visit of Orsay followed by the Orangerie (where Monet's Water Lilies' series is exhibited).
- **1:30 pm** Lunch at a trendy restaurant, the hottest address during the Fashion Week.
- **4 pm** This afternoon, we suggest a stroll on your own in the Luxembourg Gardens.
- Night at your hotel.

DAY 5 – Sunday June 25th Normandy

- **9 am** Pick-up at your hotel and transfer to Bayeux.
- **10:15 am** Stop-off in Giverny for a guided visit of Monet's house and gardens.
- **1:30 pm** Lunch in Bayeux.
- **3:30 pm** Private guided visit of the town and the famous Tapestry Museum.
- Night at your hotel.

DAY 5 – Monday June 26th D-DAY

- **9 am** Pick-up at your hotel for a D-Day tour.
Visit of Sainte-Mère-l'Eglise, Pointe du Hoch, Omaha beach, the American Cemetery. Lunch break in Port-en-Bessin, at xxx.
- **5 pm** 3-hour transfer to Amboise.
- **8 pm** Arrival in Amboise. Check-in at your hotel.
- **8:30pm** Dinner in town.
- Night at Manoir des Minimes.



DAY 6 – Tuesday June 27th Loire Valley

- **10 am** Pick up at your hotel and transfer to Villandry for a guided visit of Château de Villandry and its beautiful gardens.
- Lunch at Villandry.
- **3 pm** Guided visit of Château d'Amboise
- Dinner at La Fourchette.
- Night at your hotel.

DAY 7 – Wednesday June 28th Loire Valley

- **9 am** Pick up at your hotel for a transfer to Château de Chenonceau.
- **9:30 am** Guided visit of the estate.
- **12:30 pm** Lunch break at a special E&P address.
- **3:30 pm** Guided visit of Clos Lucé, Leonardo Da Vinci's last residence.
- Check-in and night at a local hotel.

DAY 8 – Thursday June 29th Chambord

- **9 am** Pick-up at your hotel and transfer to Chambord (1 hour).
- **10:15am** Private guided visit of the most spectacular castle in the Loire Valley, ordered by François 1st and built with the help of Leonardo da Vinci.
- **12:15pm** Transfer to Paris.
- **2:00 pm** Arrival in Paris, drop-off at your hotel.



- **3:30pm** This afternoon, we suggest a light visit of the Louvre museum, to see the major masterpieces of the museum, or focus on one era or style. Your guide will then take you for a tour of the Tuileries, the gardens of the former Palais Royal. Your hotel is a 15-min walk to the museum.
- Night at your hotel.

DAY 9 – Friday June 30th Paris

- **Optional TBC** Meet your driver at your hotel for a private transfer to your cooking class.
- **10am - 2:30pm TBC** This morning, meet your chef for a true culinary experience. Follow him to the market to select the right ingredients, then join him at his apartment to cook together a typical French meal, complete with starter, main course and dessert. At the end, savor the delicious result of your labor, together with your cook.
- This afternoon, we suggest a tour of the Eiffel Tower on your own.
- Night at your hotel.
